

# Social Worker (Adults) Career Progression Matrix

The Job description explains the competency, knowledge and skills required to fulfil Social Worker Level 1 / BCP Grade H. The level descriptors below explain the additional competency, knowledge and skills to progress to the next level.

Should training not be available for Level 2 / BCP Grade I, a commitment to undertake this training is required. Should the required training not be undertaken when available, or not successfully completed, this may result in consideration being given to redeployment to a lower graded Social Work role where there is a suitable vacancy and with no payment protection.

AMHP level 4 / BCP Grade K posts: it is a condition of your employment that you must be warranted to act as an Approved Mental Health Professional (AMHP) and retain your status as an AMHP throughout your employment in this post. Redeployment, where there is a suitable vacancy, will be considered in a lower grade post where AMHP status and active duty is not maintained.
